

# A GENERAL TIMELINE



## ADMISSION & PRE-ARRIVAL

Log in to your applicant portal, accept your offer of admission, pay your enrollment deposit (required for some programs) and you will be #UCONNBOUND. [Attend ISSS online Pre-arrival Webinars for all the latest UConn information and live Q&A](#) to help prepare for your arrival to campus.



## I-20/DS-2019

[Submit the I-20/DS-2019 request in the ISSS Portal.](#) You will need your UConn NetID to get started. After submitting your request we will review it and issue your initial I-20/DS-2019 electronically.



## SEVIS I-901 FEE

The fee can only be paid after your I-20/DS-2019 has been issued. [The fee must be paid prior to your visa interview.](#)

- F-1 applicants pay \$350
- J-1 applicants pay \$220



## VISA INTERVIEW

Visa processing times vary from country to country and can be lengthy, [make your appointment as early as possible.](#) The earliest your visa can be issued is 365 days before your program start date.



## TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

Federal regulations allow F-1 students and J-1 exchange visitors to enter the US no earlier than 30 days prior to the program start date on the I-20/DS-2019.



## HEALTH & IMMUNIZATIONS

[All UConn students must provide evidence of required immunizations.](#) Submit the Health History Form as early as possible or by July 1 for Fall term or January 1 for Spring term.



## TUITION

[Fee bills are due prior to the start of classes.](#) Pay your fee bill on time to avoid additional charges. Fee bills are due August 1 for Undergraduate students and the Friday before classes begin for Graduate students.



## Submit Arrival Documents

[Complete the Arrival Checklist and submit arrival documents](#) in the ISSS Portal as soon as you arrive in the U.S. This is time-sensitive and needs to be done promptly after arrival.
